

True Volunteer Foundation (TVF), a unique award-winning NGO, is working in partnership with local businesses across Merton to deliver sporting opportunities to children between the ages of 10 and 14 years. The project seeks to inspire athletes of the future and encourage children to live healthy and active lives through sport.

The Wimbledon Sporting Project is a five-year educational programme which includes films, books and sporting activities provided to schools in the London Borough of Merton at no cost. In 2012, 87 individuals, 39 local partners, 18 young sporting hopefuls and 21 sporting celebrities, all donated their time, expertise and resources to produce an inspirational film and book, titled Common Ground. This year, TVF will work in partnership with more local businesses to build on this foundation and deliver free professional sporting opportunities to 27,000 school children across Merton.

Professional sports coaching to schools

In 2012, three pilot sport engagement programmes took place where professional instructors delivered tailored sport packages directly to children on school premises. The programme spanned 5 days at 3 schools and enabled 1,800 children to participate in a variety of sports. The feedback was amazing...
